  - i. 37.1 of 100 in readability
  - ii. Flesch Kincaid Reading Ease (37.1) Orange
    - Based on a 0-100 scale. A high score means the text is easier to read. Low scores suggest the text is complicated to understand.

## 4. Suggested Improvements:

- i. One of the first improvements is to make the typography more accessible to a wider audience; some of the text on the web page is too small, and therefore a bit hard to read, so the size of the text should be increased somewhat; some of the text is also cluttered, making it difficult to distinguish, so increasing the font size should also help space out letters and numbers to not look so generally molded together (examples of too small text could include the listings on the front page under the "Popular Gifts Right Now" tab)
- ii. Some of the text is a bit hard to read because it's too thin without much emphasis on it, so I believe they should bold some of the text to make it stick out more, such as at the bottom of the page where it says: "What is Etsy?" and such
- iii. Some of the text in the clickable tabs near the top of the page just right below the search bar are not only too small, but the color is hard to read, as it seems to be a gray of some kind; the size of the text should once again be increased, and the color of the text should be of a slightly darker color, as it causes me to see lines when I look away from the screen
